### Read and remember

The red coloured words in the paragraph given above are known as Preposition. A preposition is placed before a noun or pronoun. It tells us where a thing, person or place is.



**Some more examples of preposition :** over ; for ; by ; through ; under ; behind ; in front of ; beside ; along.

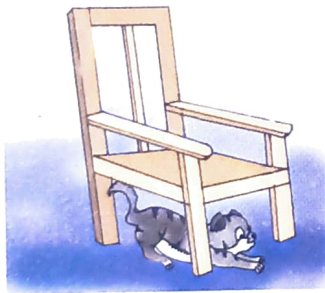
