Scene I

Rahul: You are great aunt. I'm so hungry.

All : We are too!

Radha: Mini has not yet come. I should wait for her.

Rashmi: Oh, she won't come. She refused to attend the party,

the day I went to her house for giving the invitation.

All : Why? [They are shocked.]

Mrinal : She does not want to mix up with friends. She likes to

stand aloof from her friends, specially from our group.

Rubi : Something is wrong! [To herself.]

Scene II

examination.

Rubi : After fifteen days, our examination starts. So we

have to.


Mrs Baruah : It's very good. Go. Mini is in her room.

[Mini becomes a little irritated.]

OK. [Not paying any heed.] Mini

> [Rubi steps out of the room feeling very bad. She hears some rattling of cups and saucers coming from the kitchen and gets that Mini's mother is busy in the

kitchen.]

Scene III

[The examination is over. The leisure time in the school. Rahul, Nitin, Rubi and Rashmi are all sitting inside their classroom. Rubi seems to be absorbed in deep thoughts. All of them are waiting for the room to be deserted.]

: Rubi, you said that you were going to tell us something. Nitin

What's that?

: You seem to be worried. Rahul

Rashmi: Any problem?

Yes, very big! [She gazed down at the floor.] Rubi

Rashmi: Oh, come on... will you say?

: Mini is soon going to be ruined. Rubi

Don't say anything about her. She has changed Nitin

completely. [A little agressively] No need to mention her

name in our discussion. These days she does not even look at us. She thinks herself to be more intelligent than anybody else.

Rahul: She has made friends with Anu, Akash and Nipu.

Always stays close with them.



Rashmi: She's started a bad habit of talking inside the

classroom. Earlier she was not so.
